Founded in 1988 by the Government of Canada but now recognized world-wide, EcoLogo™ is North America's largest, most respected environmental standard and certification mark. The EcoLogo program is managed by TerraChoice, a sister organization of UL Environment.

Plasti-Fab developed a certification listing to demonstrate compliance with the EcoLogo environmental criteria certification document **CCD 016: Thermal Insulation Materials**. The EcoLogo certification mark illustrated below on PlastiSpan and DuroFoam insulation, Advantage ICF System and Insulspan SIP System emphasizes our commitment to environmental responsibility in the manufacture and use of our products.

EcoLogo certification criteria emphasize requirements to reduce stress on the environment by encouraging the buying and selling of environmentally preferable products and services. To be certified, manufacturers need to demonstrate environmental management of the total life cycle performance of the product, which includes how it is made, what it is made with, how it is used, what will happen when it is disposed of and its potential for being recycled.
